NOTES

X1 Please remove the doors of a refrigerator or freezer before placing outside for pickup. Should you have to replace an appliance or water heater in the period between the County's Spring and Fall large item pickup, you may take your times to the maintenance yard for a nominal disposal fee.

X2 These items must be of a size and weight readily handled by one person.

X3 Items such as drain-o, furniture polish, cleaning products, weed or bug killers, antifreeze, etc. should be give to a neighbor for their use, if possible, rather than go to waste. To dispose of properly, watch for an announcement in local newspapers for drop-off points established by the Albermarle Regional Solid Waste Management Authority. Call Scott Sawyer, Dare County Director of Recycling (252-475-5890) for further information.

X4 Leak-proof containers required.

X5 Watch for notices of a county "paint swap" to dispose of paint. Alternatively, you can also remove the cover, mix in some kitty litter and allow the paint to fully dry. When dry, the paint may be placed in your regular garbage.

X6 The Kill Devil Hills Recycling Center on Colington Road or the Dare County Sanitation Transfer Station on Roanoke Island will accept these items. Please note that bottles and cans must be clean with labels removed. Newsprint and cardboard must be separated.

X7 These items must be of a size and weight readily handled by one person. No large deposits in the maintenance yard.

X8 The maintenance yard does not accept tires – on or off the rims.

X9 Small amounts of shrub or tree trimmings only (no limb greater than 3" in diameter). Pampas grass trimmings and vines cannot be chipped, so they cannot be accepted. Only three pickup truck loads per day, please.
