

Fireworks

The 4th of July is right around the corner, and we just wanted to remind everyone that not only are fireworks (pyrotechnics) prohibited based on the Colington Harbour ordinances:

Section 3. Fireworks, Firecrackers, Etc. Fireworks, firecrackers or similar devices which create explosive sounds or explosions or potential fire hazards or noise disturbance across a property boundary or public space when fired into the air or on the ground are strictly prohibited.

...but they are also illegal in the State of North Carolina, unless secured written authority has been received by the Dare Board of Commissioners.
